Ahepaaua of Waipouli . No 4

Received the following Petition ^{Walter and James} Honolulu Aug 28th 1872

To the Honorable Henry M. Bryan Commissioner of Boundaries &c of the Island of Hawaii

The undersigned Guardians of the person and property of William L. Lunalilo would respectfully ask that the Boundaries of the Ahepaaua of Waipouli situated in the District of Puna Island of Hawaii may be defined and settled. The Survey and notes are herewith filed

The land of Waipouli is bounded on the North by Kapaa belonging to the Crown. South by Oluhana belonging to Kiamoku and by the Sea

Thereupon appointed the 7th day of November 1872 for the hearing of said petition at Waipouli, and caused due notice to be served on the owners of the several lands about ground at 10 am.

G. W. Wilson for the crown

Pau for his children and Government.

The following witnesses were then sworn Pahuwai, Hoolepa, Kahew, Hululu and from their evidence now on file the following decision was rendered, and survey ordered.

Decision in reference to the boundary of the Ahepaaua of Waipouli by Henry M. Bryan Commissioner of Boundaries 7th November 1872

Commencing at NE corner of land on sea shore at a hole in rocks called Kaleapalepa thence to path near marsh called Kahew, thence to Waterpool Maka hakaupanahi, thence to auwai, Kololoku, thence to stone Pehapohoiki thence to ridge Hululuwa, thence to Puakei near hau thence thence past an old hau tree across stream to hau

clump called Kaloualei thence to top of ridge Kunaima
Kaimakani thence to site of old houses Pohani, thence to
Pouhiahukou, thence to stream Kawakulana, thence to old
houses Kapukailei, thence to little hill Kaimamane, thence
to Kahimatalana. Junction of the boundaries of Kapapa
Waipouli and Oloha, thence down SE boundary to a place
called Loauwaka, thence to stream Kapapa, thence to top
of ridge Puopai, thence along ridge to two grassy pali +
stream to Kulelepali, thence to Kopaea, thence over ridge
to stream Makana, thence to Kula Kalasiawikiwiki, thence
to a large hole called Ulatana, thence to a flat patch
called Waialeale thence to a hill of stones Kapouma-
kaale thence to Kaunamawa (canoe harbour), thence
to hole in reef Keununi, thence to edge of reef at a
place called Pohakawa, thence along reef to follow of com-
mencement



At all the stations on this survey there
 was been a bottle put in the ground and broken and
 round which were three stones or three holes have been dug
 thus 

The bearings noted here are from true north of
 starting point. for further information refer to plan
