# Boundary of the Ahupuaa of Lumahai

Received notice from Charles R Bishop owner of the Ahupuaa of Lumahai to have the Boundary of that land settled and defined, also received intimation that W James Gay has been empowered to act for said owner if convenient for him to do so.

Thereupon appointed the 6<sup>th</sup> day of Oct A D 1873 for the hearing of said petition and caused notice to be served on the several witnesses and the owners of the adjoining land.

## Momooiki Swam

The North eastern boundary of this land commences on the sea shore at a place called Koahoolinaipatwai from thence up side of hill to ridge called Koloakolu

# Boundary of the Ahupua'a of Lunalai

## Kanohohu Stream

This boundary commences on the sea shore at a place called Kahoolimapaikai from thence up the side of hill to ridge called Kolokolu, thence up ridge to Lauhala tree Kaluahee thence up ridge to Waianui, thence to Lauhala Kaluanaihai thence across gulch and up ridge to Kealaunui, thence up ridge to peak Moi, thence up ridge to Helele, thence to Pipiwai thence to Kaheloa, thence to gulch Keola, thence to Kaluaohakoo, thence to Kawailoa, thence to Hapuupeu, thence to Pulehua, the junction of this land with Hanalei, thence down the Eastern Boundary to Namoloakama thence down to Kapaile, thence to high hill Neki thence to Kolepeu thence to Keokaiawalea thence to orange trees at Kaoo the junction with Waipa and Waikohu thence to Pohakupili, thence to Puuhananai, thence to Lepahee, thence to Kalahala thence to sea and round to place of commencement.

## Survey Order

### Notes of Survey of Lumahee Situated on the Island of Hawaii

The North East corner of this land commences on the sea shore at a rocky point called Kahalahala, and runs thence N 1.21 W 2000 chains and ten links crossing over the top of a conical hill close to the beach and on to top of spout called Lepahee. Thence S 74.16 W 760 links along the ridge thence S 69.11 W 1300 links to Puuhanauea, thence S 10.58 W 3200 links passing Pohakupeli a large prominent stone on the spur, thence S 23.50 W 2460 links thence S 1.19 E 5820 links to Keokiwalea thence S 16.9 W 3950 links along the ridge, thence S 26.6 E 1540 links up the ridge to a sharp peak or knot called Kolepeea thence S 20.36 E 9460 links to a peak called Puuhonauwehea (opposing the ridge to the west of the Heaung is the boundary, thence S 81.36 E 3860 links along the ridge to Neki or Namalaewa thence S 27.10 E 41 chains 20 links to a peak called Kapoulu, thence S 36.45 E 3240 links to a peak called Halauba thence S 40. E 2440 links to sharp peak, thence S 34.30 E 3360 links to the top of mountain called Namoolu Kama

Returning to place of commencement at Kahalahala the Northern boundary of this land runs N 75.41 W 5300 links, along sandy beach and crossing river, and on up to the top of spout called Kolepeea, thence N 49.50 W over the face of spout to sea shore distance about two chains thence from Kolepeea the boundary runs thence S 40.10 W 1200 links along the ridge, thence S 53.5 W 379 links along ridge to Makai side of the river, crossing spout, thence S 29.20 W 409 links thence S 41.4 W 879 links along the ridge, to place called

 Thence S 19° 36' W 1122 links along the ridge and 50 links west of some  
Lauhala trees, Thence S 11° 1' W 1190 links along ridge, when there is  
 a Lauhala and a large hole called Kaluamakahai, Thence S 39° 34' W  
 1360 links crossing a gully and over on to the point of Apuu Thence  
 S 71° W 620 links up Apuu Thence S 31° 55' W 418 links up Apuu  
 Thence S 75° 46' W 491 links, Thence S 39° 0' W 794 links Thence S 87°  
 16' W 961 links, Thence N 76° 36' W 428 links to the top of Apuu  
 Thence S 37° 6' W 978 links up the ridge Thence S 84° 24' W 169  
 links to the top of Kealahou Thence S 4° 28' W 3800 links to  
Moi. (The boundary from Kealahou follows along water shed of ridge  
 up and round the head of Lumaikai valley and down to the  
 beach at Kahalahou) Thence S 16° 24' W 3500 links to Hilele  
 Thence S 6° 54' W 5760 links to Pipiwai, Thence S 5° 39' W 6400  
 links to Kahihou, Thence S 14° 36' E 5000 links to Kealahou  
 Thence in a south east direction along the ridge to gulch called  
Kawaialea, Thence up the ridge going around the gulch to a  
 place called Kaleapohakukoo, Thence along ridge to Kawaialea  
 Thence Hapuu Thence along the ridge to Palehua the  
 junction with Hanalei, which is the south East corner of this  
 land, Thence following round range of Mount and on a N.W.  
 direction to Namoulihana the end of survey, on the eastern boundary  
 of this land, (see plan) and containing an area of Three  
Thousand one hundred and Fifty acres more or less, 3150  
acres.

N.B. At all practicable places on this survey and when dis-  
 visible marks have been put in the ground either a stone with  
 broken bottle beneath or a trench with a broken bottle in the  
 center.
