JUDGMENT.

An application to decide and certify the boundaries of the Land
of Kauai District of Waimea Island of
Kauai having been filed with me on the 1 day of November
1870 by Napiolani Malabana.

in accordance with the provisions of an Act to facilitate the settlement of Boundaries, &c., approved on the 22d day of June, A. D. 1868; now, therefore, having duly received and heard all the testimony offered in reference to the said boundaries and having gone on the said land, at the request of

Mr O' Donnells & H. A. Widenmann
and having endeavored otherwise to obtain all information possible to enable me to arrive at a just decision, which will more fully appear by reference to the records of this matter by me kept in Book No. 1, page 13, and it appearing to my satisfaction that the true, lawful and equitable boundaries, are as follows, viz:

Commencing at two small stones in the ground a short distance from a double branch prong of India tree. near the East bank of the Naupape River, and following along the Eastern bank of said Naupape River. thence crossing a branch of Naupape River. thence crossing the principal stream and running to the eastern side of Waterlead. the centre of which forms the boundary of this land. thence following the said water lead to wher

it joins the Hanapepe River, thence following
the river to the sea. Thence crossing a sand
spit and mouth of Hanapepe River to a rocky
point overlooking the sea, thence returning ~~on~~
the Eastern Bank of the river in all its wind-
ing and turning to place of commencement.

It is therefore adjudged and I do hereby
decide and certify that the boundaries of the
said land are and here after shall be as here-
inafter set forth.

river. Thence following the river to
the sea, thence crossing a sand
spit and mouth of Hanapepe river
to a rocky point overlooking the
sea, thence returning on the
eastern bank of the river in all its
windings and turnings to place of
commencement
