JUDGMENT.

An application to decide and certify the Boundaries of the Land of Waipouli District of Puna Island of Kauai having been filed with me on the 28 day of August, 1872 by Charles R. Bishop and Cha. Kawana Guardians of Wm. L. Lunalilo in accordance with the provisions of an Act to facilitate the settlement of Boundaries, &c., approved on the 22d day of June, A. D. 1868; now, therefore, having duly received and heard all the testimony offered in reference to the said boundaries and having gone on the said land, at the request of W. H. Rice counsel for the Petitioners and having endeavored otherwise to obtain all information possible to enable me to arrive at a just decision, which will more fully appear by reference to the records of this matter by me kept in Book No. 1, page 21, and it appearing to my satisfaction that the true, lawful and equitable boundaries, are as follows, viz:

Commencing at the North East corner of this land on the sea shore at a hole in rocks called Kaluapalejoo. Thence to pathway near marsh called Heahu. Thence to Waterpool. Makahaakupanahi. Thence to Auwai. Kolokolo. Thence to Stones. Pohopohuiki. Thence to ridge Hulumoa. Thence to Puakei near Hau trees. Thence past an old Kukui tree across stream to Hau clump called Kalouuku. Thence to

tops of ridge Himaimakamakani, Thence to
site of old houses Panene, Thence to Kaukahoku
Thence to stream Kawaiholana, Thence to old
houses Kapukraiki, Thence to little hill Kai-
wamane, Thence to Kahimalanai, Junction
of the Boundaries of Kapoa Waiפוولي and
Olohuwa, Thence down South East boundary
to a place called Laauwaha, Thence to stream
Kapapa, Thence to tops of ridge Papoi.
Thence along ridge to Kow grove Pali and
stream to Kulipale, Thence to Kopoa
Thence over ridge to stone Makana, Thence
to Kula Kalawikiwiki, Thence to a large
hole called Ualena, Thence to Kalpatches
called Waialeale, Thence to a hill of stones
Kapunaakalu, Thence to Kaunawaa (canoe
harbour), Thence to hole in reef Kumunui
Thence to edge of reef at a place called
Pohakua, Thence along reef to place of
commencement.

It is therefore adjudged and I
do hereby decide and certify that the boundaries
of the said land are and hereafter shall be
as hereinafore set forth
