JUDGMENT.

An application to decide and certify the Boundaries of the Land
of Kalalau District of Hanalei Island of
Kauai having been filed with me on the 15 day of September
1873 by Edwin O Hall

in accordance with the provisions of an Act to facilitate the settlement of Boundaries, &c., approved on the 22d day of June, A. D. 1868; now, therefore, having duly received and heard all the testimony offered in reference to the said boundaries and having gone on the said land, at the request of

Henry Johnston
and having endeavored otherwise to obtain all information possible to enable me to arrive at a just decision, which will more fully appear by reference to the records of this matter by me kept in Book No. 1, page 117 1/2 and it appearing to my satisfaction that the true, lawful and equitable boundaries, are as follows, viz:

The North East Boundary of this land commences on the sea shore at a place called Naupaka, and thence runs up face of mountain to a place where the gods used to have sacrifices offered to them called Keahipohaka thence to a resting place called Kauakou thence to high peak called Puuki, thence to high peak Koalahema; thence to the highest peak on Eastern Boundary called Alealea, thence round ridge to Kaala thence round ridge to Kahoolaw

Thence to ridge about center of valley Haa-
punui. Thence to junction with Waima at
Pihia Thence along Waima Boundary to Alii
nui continuing along Waima Boundary to
Kawailoa, and along same Boundary to Puu
ohila and from thence to a large and peculiarly
shaped rock each side representing a land &
called Pohakuwaawa at this rock the Bound-
ary of Waima terminates with this land
and this land then joins the Boundary of
Honopuu and Neulolo. From Pohakuwaawa
the Boundary runs to face of bluff Kalahu
Thence to high peak with round hole through
top called Keonapuka. Thence down precipice
to Kalahii. Thence to Peak Waihona
Thence down to sea shore at Kalaipuka and
from thence round to place of commencement

It is therefore adjudged and I do
hereby decree and certify that the boundaries
of said land are and hereafter shall be
as hereunto set forth
