JUDGMENT.

An application to decide and certify the boundaries of the Land  
of Wawaopuhi District of Hanalei Island of  
Hawaii having been filed with me on the 15 day of September  
1873 by Edwin O. Hall Minister of Interior

in accordance with the provisions of an Act to facilitate the settlement of Boundaries, &c., approved on the 22d day of June, A. D. 1868; now, therefore, having duly received and heard all the testimony offered in reference to the said boundaries and having gone on the said land, at the request of

Henry Johnson agent for Government Lands and having endeavored otherwise to obtain all information possible to enable me to arrive at a just decision, which will more fully appear by reference to the records of this matter by me kept in Book No. 1, page 240, and it appearing to my satisfaction that the true, lawful and equitable boundaries, are as follows, viz: The Eastern Boundary of this land commences on the sea shore at a place called Kawaiopapa thence to a ridge called Keakalau, thence to a peak called Puu - opono thence along flat land through forest to a rich when several lands join and called Pohakuwaawaa, thence through woods called Ihi thence to a spring on top of Bluff and called Kapunawaapsuker, thence to a gulch or gorge called Matvalani thence down ridge Wakaloalu, thence to two stems on <sup>ridge</sup> Hele of

bluff called Napahakau, thence down to a large  
rock on side of Pali called Hoonoo thence to  
house lots called Mulihale, thence to sea at  
a place called Pipii, thence to two rocks in  
sea one of which belongs to Neulolo and the  
other to Wawapsuki and called Kaohiohakau  
and from thence round to place of commencement

It is therefore adjudged and I  
do hereby decide and certify that the boundaries  
of the said lands are and hereafter shall be  
as hereinbefore set forth.
