JUDGMENT.

An application to decide and certify the boundaries of the Land of Waimea District of Waimea Island of Kauai having been filed with me on the 14 day of July 1873 by Ins O. Davies Commissioner of Lands (Crown) and Land Agent in accordance with the provisions of an Act to facilitate the settlement of Boundaries, &c., approved on the 22d day of June, A. D. 1868; now, therefore, having duly received and heard all the testimony offered in reference to the said boundaries and having gone on the said land, at the request of

James W. Gray and having endeavored otherwise to obtain all information possible to enable me to arrive at a just decision, which will more fully appear by reference to the records of this matter by me kept in Book No. 1, page 140, and it appearing to my satisfaction that the true, lawful and equitable boundaries, are as follows, viz:

The south East corner of this land commences at the mouth of the Waimea River on its Eastern Bank, and thence runs S.W. along the sea shore to Laohokole, thence continuing along beach to Kawale, thence to Olachotani thence along shore to Moelaw. thence along shore to Nohole in Mana (Sounding Sands) thence continuing along beach to Kapiai, thence along beach to Polihali, here ends the sand beach and begins the rocky coast and pales, thence

along the rocky coast to point at Milolii.
Thence past Alapuu point by Neololo to point
N.E. of Neololo bay and called Puanauia the
W.W. corner of this land and S.W. corner of Wa-
wapuhi a government land. From this point
the Boundary runs up face of Pali to Pak and
continuing along the ridge to Pohakauwaa
a large and peculiarly shaped stone, on the
East brow of Kaumokuwa ridge. From this stone
the Boundary follows the watershed of the Kau-
mokuwa ridge through forest land, and along
the top of pali overlooking Katalau to the
top of a high noted peak called Pumphead
the S.E. corner of Katalau and S.W. corner of Poha-
kau, thence the Boundary continues along
watershed of mountain range bounded on the
East by the Land of Wainaha to where it joins
the land of Makawele at a place called Ta-
pokai the N.E. corner of this land and S.W. corner
of Wainaha.

The Eastern Boundary of this land
runs from place of commencement along the land
of Makawele up the Eastern Bank of the Wainaha
River to opposite the junction of the Wainaha and
Makawele rivers, thence up along East bank
of river to stone --- thence to auway and
up to cliff above Makawele Valley thence
up ridge to cactus bushes thence up ridge
to top of Nahalaka thence to Kalehuahakihaki
the North West corner of Makawele thence

following in an Easterly Direction the Watershed
of the ridge, to Rapaki the East corner of this
land and junction with the W.E. boundary.

It is therefore adjudged and I
do hereby decide and certify that the boundaries
of the said land are and hereafter shall be as
hereinafter set forth.

The South East corner of these land commences at the mouth of the Waimea River on its eastern bank. The Survey commences at a trig station on the South west corner of old Russian Fort on the land of Haka neli from this trig station Punalauia Δ on Kakaneli bears $S\ 88^{\circ} 37' E$ true, var. of the Yards $Y^{\circ} 11'$. Halemau Kahi Kahi peak a high range on the boundary on these lands and Kakaneli peak $N\ 26^{\circ} 50' E$ true $Y^{\circ} 19^{\circ} 20'$ May.
